We are pleased to announce Holy Name School's partnership with Westside Nutrition Services for the upcoming school year.

Westside Nutrition Services believes that a multi-faceted approach to healthy lifestyles to children is necessary. Their focus is on delivering meals to schools that not only meet nutritional guidelines as set forth by the National School Lunch Program but meals the students will eat and enjoy.

Meal Options

Grades K through 2 will be given a one meal lunch option which will be a hot entrée

Grades 3 through 8 will be given a two meal lunch option – hot entrée or cold entrée

While we are navigating this new lunch service there will not be any extra entrees available until we become more familiar with the new food service process. When the extra entrée becomes available to order the cost will be an additional \$1.10.

Menus will be available at the Fall Open House.

Cost

Breakfast is \$1.50 and reduced price is .40 cents

Lunch is \$2.50 and reduced price is .50 cents

Our school will be participating in the federally funded Free/Reduced Lunch Program. Applications will be available at the Fall Open House on Monday, August 17th from 5 – 6:30 p.m. and these forms will also be included in the 1st day of school paperwork.

We are working on scheduling a day for parents to come and sample this new food service with their child (ren) and further information will be sent.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING LUNCH ORDERS FOR STUDENTS ARRIVING AFTER 8:30 A.M.

If your child is arriving after 8:30 a.m. they will need to bring a cold sack lunch as lunch counts and orders will have been submitted for the day.
